

Emerging Artists of Color Residency 2022

For Muskegon County artists of color ages 16-20

Program Description

Muskegon County artists who identify as Black, Indigenous, or People of Color, ages 16-20, are invited to apply for the second-annual Arts Council of White Lake-Nuveen Center (ACWL-Nuveen) Emerging Artists of Color Residency. Sponsored by a grant from the Muskegon Community Foundation's Youth Advisory Council, this three-week program will provide one local artist working with 2-dimensional media a studio space, materials and up to 72 hours of dedicated time to work on a visual art project of their choice. The chosen artist will receive a \$1,000 stipend and special mentoring from two accomplished painters, J Arthur Sanders and Tatsuki Hakoyama. The mentors will meet individually with the artist and help guide them toward creating a body of work that will be exhibited at the ACWL-Nuveen within six months of the completion of the residency.

Details:

- The residency will take place August 2 19, 2022
- The artist must commit to 65 total hours of personal studio time at the ACWL-Nuveen over the course of three weeks. The ACWL-Nuveen is open Tuesday-Friday from 11:00am 5:30pm and Saturday 11:00am 3:00pm
- The artist will receive \$500 upon completion of the first 30 hours of studio work and the remaining \$500 upon completion of the entire three weeks in the studio. The artist can work with any supplies in stock at the ACWL-Nuveen and staff will order other supplies to help them complete their project, within reason.
 - The artist must present an exhibition of the artwork created during their residency at the ACWL-Nuveen and/or another offsite venue.
- If transportation to Whitehall is a barrier, it will be provided.
